



Graduates must arrive at least 45 minutes prior to the scheduled start of the ceremony.

Graduates are expected to refrain from disruptive behavior.

The graduation tassel is initially placed on the right hand side of the cap and moved to the left hand side when the graduate is instructed to move it.

The only items permitted as a part of the graduation regalia are those issued by Roseman University of Health Sciences. No adornments to the graduation regalia are permitted.

Examples of adornments include, but are not limited to, tape or writing on caps, leis or other necklaces worn outside the robe, and corsages and boutonnieres.

Graduates should not carry any items with them in their hands as they process to their seats.

Graduates are expected to wear appropriate clothing beneath the regalia. Business casual attire, at a minimum, is expected.

Graduates are expected to return to their seats after the on-stage presentation and remain seated for the duration of the ceremony.

Graduates will not be permitted to.
